For gaining an indulgence five general conditions (being in a state of grace, detachment from sin, confessing one's sins sacramentally, receiving the Eucharist, and praying for the Pope) are required. The conditions should be fulfilled on the day itself or close to it, with the exception of sacramental confession, where it is sufficient that it be celebrated within several days (about 20) before or after the indulgenced act. Indulgences *can* always *be applied either to oneself or to the souls of the deceased*, but they cannot be applied to other persons living on earth.
